Dr. Walley is an internist and addiction medicine specialist at Boston Medical Center and an Assistant Professor of Medicine at Boston University School of Medicine. He directs the Boston University Addiction Medicine Fellowship program. He also provides primary care and office-based buprenorphine treatment for HIV patients at Boston Medical Center and methadone maintenance treatment at Community Substance Abuse Centers. Dr. Walley is the Medical Director for the MA Dept. of Public Health's Opioid Overdose Prevention Pilot Program, and has co-authored over 40 peer-reviewed research articles.
